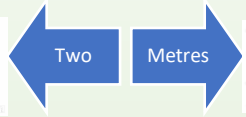


HANDS – FACE- SPACE

Frequently Asked Questions – aka competition rules

Who can enter?

Entrants must attend one of the Hughenden Schools or pre-schools.

What are the age categories?

Categories: up to Year 1; Years 2 -5; Year 6.

What materials must be used?

Materials: should be limited to those found at home so you can be really creative!

What size picture?

A4 please. You will may need to 'zip' the picture to upload.

How will the pictures be judged?

What information must be provided?

The title of the picture, child's name, age, address and telephone number should be included when the picture is being uploaded. Personal details will not be shared and will be deleted no later than mid-November.

How will the pictures be judged?

A panel of local judges will be set up. Their decisions will be final.

What is the deadline for submissions?

All pictures must be received by 6.00pm on Sunday 1st November 2020.

When will the results be announced?

The panel will convene remotely and the winners will notified on Thursday 5th November.

Where will be results be published?

The results will be published in the HSA weekly newsletter published each Thursday, on the HSA Facebook page and sent to all Residents Associations for uploading onto their respective websites.

Are there prizes?

Yes there will be some small prizes for each winner and runner-up.
